**Day 2 – Costa del Sol:** Upon arrival in Malaga Airport, proceed through immigration and collect your baggage. Long regarded as one of Europe’s most cosmopolitan holiday spots, the Costa del Sol will satisfy the wishes of sightseers, sportsmen and shoppers alike.

**Days 3 - 7 – Costa del Sol:** Enjoy the next five days at leisure. Known for its endless variety of entertainment, water sports and nightlife, the Benalmadena Coast and its lively neighboring town of Torremolinos are popular European seaside resorts with something for everyone - sightseers, sportsmen and shoppers alike.

The growth of the Benalmadena Coast over the past thirty years has been spectacular, most notably is this seaside resort’s new Selwo Marina dotted with cafés, restaurants and a pedestrian beach promenade. Having experienced less development than Torremolinos, the Benalmadena Coast has managed to maintain it’s traditional Andalusian flavor and the actual town of Benalmadena still resembles one of the regions many picturesque white washed villages. When in town, don’t miss the 17<sup>th</sup> century Church of Santo Domingo with its pretty gardens and the interesting Archeology Museum.

The area’s geographical position, between Benalmadena Beach and the Mijas Mountains, allows for the best climate in Europe with 320 days of sun per year and temperatures ranging from 16 to 30 degrees Celsius (61 to 86 degrees Fahrenheit). And with nine kilometers of beaches in excellent condition, the residents of the area and visitors can enjoy strolling the beaches and seaside promenades for most of the year. Benalmadena’s beach even comes with its own castle! Built in the 1930’s in traditional Moorish style, Bil-Bil Castle located directly across from the beach, is an excellent stop for a photo opportunity.

Recently the Costa del Sol is being re-dubbed the “Costa del Golf” this is in response to the spectacular Golf Courses that have been designed by the likes of Seve Ballesteros, Peter Alliss and Clive Clark. There are more than 40 quality courses to be played throughout the Costa del Sol making it a perfect destination for the golf enthusiast.

**Day 8 – Costa del Sol/U.S.:** After breakfast transfer on your own to the airport for your return flight home.
